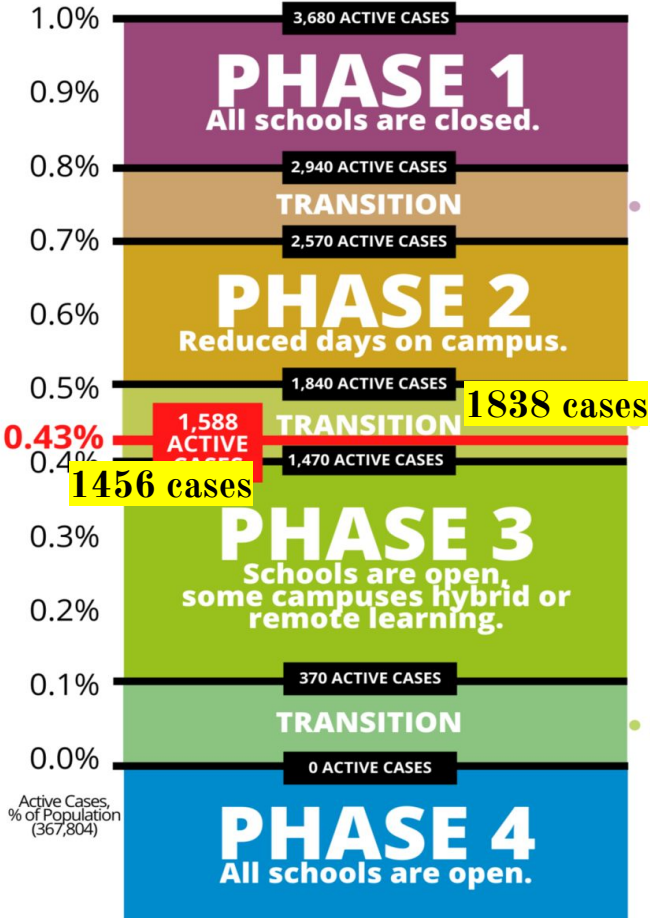

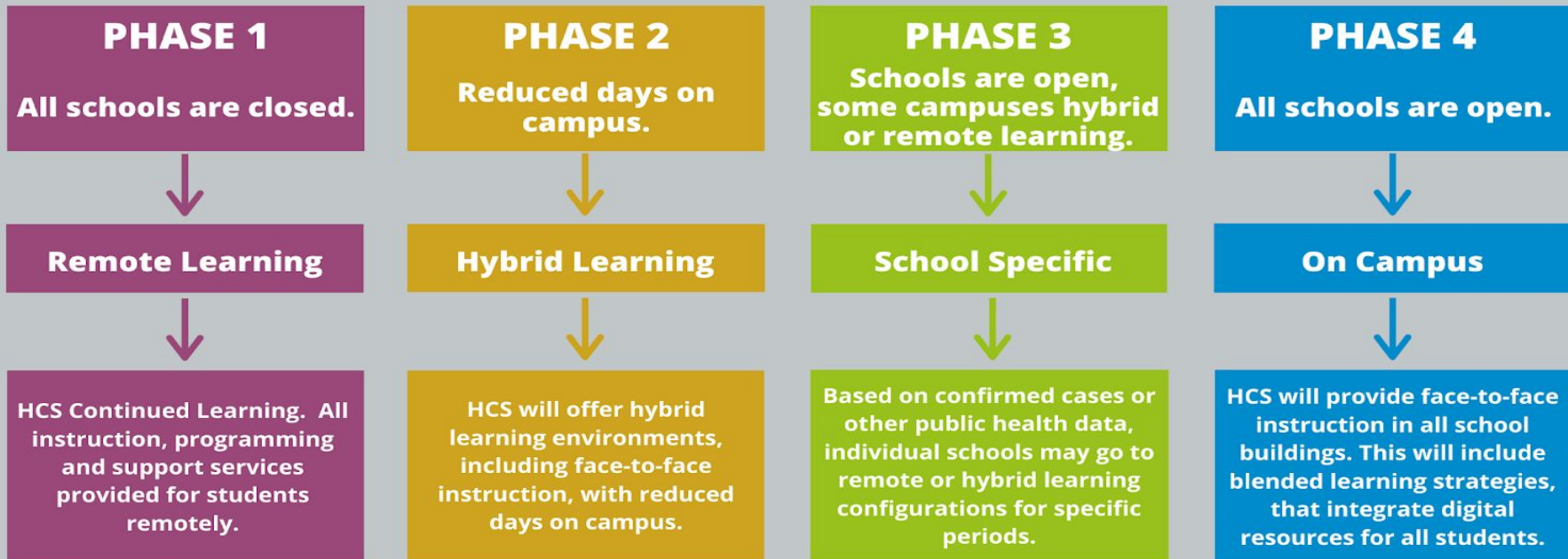

FAMILY OPTIONS FOR 2020-2021 SCHOOL YEAR

OPTION 1: HCS Learning Continuum Plan



OPTION 2: HCSatHome Program

All HCS families have the option to chose HCSatHome learning program with their base school for the full semester, regardless of what phase the district is in for in-person instruction. Families must register ahead of each semester for the 2020-2021 school year.

OPTION 3: Hamilton County Virtual School

This program requires enrolling at Hamilton County Virtual School as your child's base school. The programming is self-directed and self-paced, with more reliance on parents for curriculum support and engagement. This school supports students in grades K-12.

- **Attend school on Mondays & Tuesdays**
- **Log on Wednesdays digitally**
- **Must log on synchronously Thursdays and Fridays based on class schedule**

August 13- Orientation for B-Day Students

- **Must log on synchronously Mondays and Tuesdays based on class schedule**
- **Log on Wednesdays digitally**
- **Attend school on Thursdays and Fridays**

Attendance

- **Must follow class schedule**
- **Must log onto classes daily**
- **Failure to log on to classes = Absence**
- **Absences= Tier I Parent Attendance Meetings**
- **Additional Absences= Attendance Review Board**
- **Chronic Absences= Referral to Court**

COVID-19 Protocols

- **Masks- Required**
- **Handwashing- Highly Encouraged**
- **Sanitizer- Available but students should have their own pocket sized bottle**
- **Lunch containers- Fully Covered**
- **Signage-Denotes walking 6 ft apart**
- **Social Distancing in all areas-includes classrooms**
